Per AQHA directive a drug-testing & show processing fee of \$5.00 per horse per AQHA show will be collected for remittance to AQHA. AQHA may elect to perform drug testing at this show. Ribbons or merchandise for places 1 – 6 in all youth, amateur, select & novice classes. Rosettes for Grand & Reserve Champions in halter under each judge. Entries for classes will close when the preceding class enters the ring. Refunds on scratches will be made only with the presentation of a vets/physicians statement that the horse/rider was unable to compete. A copy of the horses registration papers indicating current ownership and a current individual AQHA membership is required for each exhibitor and card must be shown or a membership must be purchased at the show. All horses entered in performance halter must produce proof of ROM to show, no exceptions.
